Judicial Ethics Opinion JE-38

Topic

May a judge serve as a member of the Kansas Commission on Governmental Standards and Conduct.

Question:

A District Judge has been asked to serve as a member of the Kansas Commission on Governmental Standards and Conduct. (K.S.A. 25-4119a). The judge asks for an opinion as to whether his service on the Commission would violate the Code of Judicial Conduct.

Answer:

The position in question is provided for by state law and as such falls within the proscription of Article 3, Section 13 of the Kansas Constitution and thus is a violation of the Code of Judicial Conduct.
