## NOTICE OF DISTRICT JUDGE VACANCY

## PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

The First Judicial District Nominating Commission will convene at 9:00 a.m., August 8, 2018, at the Leavenworth County Justice Center, to interview and select nominees whose names will be submitted to the Governor for appointment to the position of District Judge, First Judicial District.

Statutes require a district judge filling this position: (1) be regularly admitted to the practice of law in the State of Kansas; (2) be a resident of the First Judicial District at the time of taking the oath of office and maintain residency in the First Judicial District while holding such office; (3) have been engaged in the active practice of law for at least 5 years as either a lawyer, judge or full-time teacher at an accredited law school. K.S.A. 20-334; K.S.A. 4-202.

The Commission welcomes recommendations of nominees to fill the vacancy in the First Judicial District, created by the retirement of Judge Gunnar Sundby. Recommendations must be accompanied by a nomination form which is available from the Clerk of the Atchison County District Court, Clerk of the Leavenworth County District Court, the Clerk of the Appellate Courts, and at <a href="https://www.kscourts.org">www.kscourts.org</a> under "What's New". The nomination form must be completed and signed by the nominee.
