
**ORDER**

The appellant's brief in the above-captioned case shall be filed on or before February 20, 2008, as requested in the Attorney General's motion to expedite this case. The appellees' brief shall be filed within thirty days after the filing of the appellant's brief. Those parties who have been admitted as *amicus curiae* in district court may file a brief in this court without further application. Briefs of any *amicus curiae* shall be filed within thirty days after the filing of the appellant's brief. Reply briefs, if any, shall be filed within fifteen days after filing of the brief to which the reply is made. No extensions of time will be granted to any party.

The above-captioned case will be scheduled for oral argument on Wednesday, May 14, 2008, at 1:30 p.m. in the Supreme Court Courtroom, Kansas Judicial Center. Each side will be granted thirty minutes for argument. An *amicus curiae* is not entitled to be heard on oral argument.
