
It has come to the attention of the Court that there have been salary increases granted to district court employees after the May 10, 1978 directive of the Chief Justice to administrative judges.

The Judicial Administrator is directed to adjust any salary increase which was made after May 10, 1978 and paid by the state after January 1, 1979, contrary to the expressed intent of the May 10, 1978 directive construing Senate Bill 966.

It is further ordered that the office of the Judicial Administrator deduct any overpayments made to district court employees after January 1, 1979 from future pay warrants due from the state.

Administrative judges, district court administrators, and chief clerks are directed to assist the Judicial Administrator in determining any pay adjustments made necessary by this Order.
