Re: Calendar Year 2020 Holidays

Pursuant to K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 35–107, Section 8.9 of the Kansas Court Personnel Rules, and the executive memorandum issued by Governor Laura Kelly on May 10, 2019, the following dates have been approved for calendar year 2020 holidays:

New Year's Day	Wednesday, January 1, 2020
Martin Luther King, Jr. Day	Monday, January 20, 2020
Presidents Day	Monday, February 17, 2020
Memorial Day	Monday, May 25, 2020
Independence Day	Friday, July 3, 2020
Labor Day	Monday, September 7, 2020
Columbus Day	Monday, October 12, 2020
Veterans Day	Wednesday, November 11, 2020
Thanksgiving Day	Thursday, November 26, 2020
	Friday, November 27, 2020
Christmas Eve	Thursday, December 24, 2020
Christmas Day	Friday, December 25, 2020

Observance of these holidays by a district court may be deferred whenever observance of the holiday would interfere with judicial proceedings in progress.

At the discretion of the chief judge and approval of the judicial administrator, a district court may remain open on any of the above designated holidays when the local county courthouse is open for business and observes as a substitute holiday a county designated holiday not otherwise observed by the Judicial Branch.
