
OPINIONS OF THE APPELLATE COURTS

Supreme Court Rule 7.04(c) is hereby amended, effective June 24, 2004:

(c) A party or other interested person who believes that an opinion of either the Supreme Court or Court of Appeals that is not designated by the court for publication meets the standards for publication established by this rule or otherwise has substantial precedential value may file a motion in the Supreme Court asking that it be published. The motion shall state the grounds for such belief, shall be accompanied by a copy of the opinion, and shall comply with Supreme Court Rule 5.01 ~~except that service shall not be required~~ including service on all parties to the appeal.
