
CUSTODIAL STATUS OF DEFENDANT IN SENTENCING APPEALS

Supreme Court Rule 2.042 is hereby adopted, effective the date of this order:

When sentencing is challenged in a criminal appeal, appellant's counsel must include on the docketing statement information regarding defendant's custodial status. After the appeal is docketed, it is the State's obligation to notify the appellate clerk in writing of any change in the custodial status of the defendant during the pendency of the appeal.
