

IN THE SUPREME COURT OF THE STATE OF KANSAS


ORDER

Rule 501(a) provides that “[e]ach active Supreme Court Justice, Court of Appeals Judge, and District Court Judge within the State of Kansas shall earn a minimum of 40 hours of approved continuing judicial education in each 3-year period commencing January 1, 1986, with not less than 12 hours earned each calendar year.”

Because there will be only one Judicial conference in 2009, the Rule 501(a) requirement of 12 hours earned for calendar year 2009 is hereby reduced to 8 hours of approved continuing judicial education.

The remaining requirements of the Rule are unaffected by this Order.
