

## DISTRICT JUDICIAL NOMINATING COMMISSION 2019 ELECTIONS

The purpose of each commission is to nominate persons for appointment to the office of district judge and to appoint persons to the office of district magistrate judge in judicial districts that have adopted the nonpartisan method for the selection of judges.

The Clerk of the Supreme Court recently conducted elections for lawyer members whose terms are expiring on March 4, 2019. Special elections were also conducted for lawyer members appointed in 2018, whose terms are also expiring on March 4, 2019. Below are the election results.
