

SUPREME COURT NOMINATING COMMISSION ELECTION

The purpose of the nine-member commission is to recommend qualified individuals for appointment to the Kansas Supreme Court. Four of the commission members are nonlawyers and are appointed by the governor. Four commission members are attorneys elected by attorneys in each of the state's four congressional districts. The commission chair is an attorney elected by attorneys in a statewide election.

The clerk of the supreme court has recently conducted an election for a lawyer member position whose term is expiring on June 30, 2019. No nominee received a majority of the votes cast. Pursuant to K.S.A. 20-119, a run-off election will be held. The following persons are hereby declared to be the nominees receiving the greatest number of votes and shall be resubmitted to the electorate.
